- + Essential Skills Training and Opportunities for Work Experience Training earning up to \$15 per hour
- + Career Readiness Training and Certification
- + Housing and Supportive Services
- + Access to Healthcare and Counseling
- + Job Placement and MORE



Enrollment Criteria:

- Be at least 18 years old and not older than 24 years of age on the date of enrollment
- Reside in the targeted geographic area, or plan to return to the area upon release from custody of an out-of-home placement
- Have been expelled from a school OR had juvenile or adult justice system contact, defined as:
 - Current or previous incarceration; or arrest
 - Probation; parole; or out-of-home placement
 - Alternative sentence by the juvenile or adult justice system
 - Diversionary program of the juvenile or adult justice system
- Have one or more of the following risk-factors associated with delinquent or criminal activity:
 1. Juvenile or criminal record of a violent offense/infracton or crimes against persons, as defined by state law enforcement; or,
 2. Attend or attended an alternative high school for disciplinary reasons such as:
 - Left high school before completion
 - Gang membership (current or prior)
